SHORT-TERM ACTIVITIES

CAREER DISCUSSION BOARD (Career Coach)

1-2 hours/week

Respond to students'/job seekers questions online through a web discussion board relating to a particular career/company by providing advice and encouragement in their areas of interest.

COMMITTEE MEMBER

1-10 hours/week

Participate in a variety of committees that have been tasked to help develop Inspire Rock Counties community implementation.

MOCK / INFORMATIONAL INTERVIEW

30 min – 1 hour

Help students/job seekers develop their interviewing skills and provide a comfortable environment where they can practice with you and receive constructive feedback.

COMPETITION JUDGE

1 hour - 1 day

Help judge projects in math/science or other competitions and provide constructive feedback.

GUEST SPEAKER

1-2 hours

Speak to a group of students/job seekers about your:

- career path
- career experiences
- responsibilities and expertise

MEDIUM-TERM ACTIVITIES

JOB SHADOW

1 day

Take a student/job seeker through the daily ins and outs of your job, and encourage them to ask questions and to get a better understanding of your profession/industry.

SERVICE LEARNING OPPORTUNITY

1-3 hours

Provide students/job seekers an opportunity to give back to their community by allowing them to participate in a project at your company.

INTERNSHIP/ PROJECT SUPPORT

1- 3 months (may vary)

Take on an intern or provide project support that illustrates more about what it's really like working in your field and industry.
